

ORDINANCE NO. 356

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JANESVILLE, IOWA, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 92 PERTAINING TO WATER RATES.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Janesville, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. Existing Section 92.02 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Janesville, Iowa, be stricken in its entirety.

Section 2. A new Section 92.02 is adopted as follows:

92.02 RATES FOR SERVICE. Water service shall be furnished at the following monthly rates within the City.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 384.84)

1. That a Debt Service/Infrastructure Improvement Fee of \$10.00 be charged on a continuing monthly basis.

2. Metered Customers.

A. First 2,000 gallons or lesser amount used per month @ \$17.62 (minimum monthly bill), subject to an automatic annual increase of three percent (3%) to take place each new fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and annually thereafter.

B. All over 2,000 gallons used per month @ \$5.22 per 1,000 gallons, also subject to an automatic annual increase of three percent (3%) to take place each new fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and annually thereafter.

3. Non-Metered Customers. In the event it is impossible or not practicable for the installation of a water meter, the minimum monthly water service charge shall be computed on a usage of 4,000 gallons for customers with three or fewer persons within the household and computed on a usage of 8,000 gallons for customers with four or more persons within the household.

4. Bulk Fire Hydrant Water. Bulk water from fire hydrants shall be furnished at the following rates:

A. First 1,000 gallons or lesser amount used per month @\$17.62 (minimum monthly bill), subject to an automatic annual increase of three percent (3%) to take place each new fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and annually thereafter.

B. All over 1,000 gallons used per month @ \$17.62 per 1,000 gallons, subject to an automatic annual increase of three percent (3%) to take place each new fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and annually thereafter.

Provided, however, nonprofit organizations that utilize less than 1,000 gallons of water per month shall not pay a water service charge for that month.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. Any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid and unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
