General Information

All materials are sorted after collection and may be mixed together in your container. To prevent material becoming stuck, flatten all cardboard and paperboard boxes. Rinse food and liquid from recyclable items.

Plastic bags are recycled through grocers. Please do not place them in your recycle containers. Soiled recyclables are not recyclable. (oily pizza boxes, used paper napkins, etc) Electronics are not recyclable.
